

## Cookie Statement

### Introduction

Connectis's website (connectis.com) uses cookies. Cookies are small information files saved on your computer, tablet or mobile phone when you visit connectis.com. The cookies enable us to see how our site is used, so that we can help you navigate your way around it and tailor our offering to your needs.

This cookie statement describes the cookies we use and what they are used for.

### Cookies that remember settings

Connectis uses functional cookies that enable our website to work properly. For example, we use functional cookies to remember your settings and preferences, so that we don't have to ask you again each time you visit. The settings and preferences that are saved in cookies are:

- Your 'stay logged in' choice
- Your language preference

You can disable our functional cookies by adjusting your browser settings. However, if you do that, you will need to repeat your preferences each time you visit.

### Cookies that record statistical data

We use Google Analytics cookies to collect statistical data about how visitors use our website. The statistical data collected includes information about where visitors come from and what they click on, as well as how many visitors we get and how quickly our pages load.

### Marketing cookies

Connectis uses marketing cookies, also known as 'third-party cookies' to collect information about how you use our website. The information collected includes details of the pages you visit, how long you spend on each page, what pages you reach us from and where you go to next. We also use marketing cookies to manage the forms on the website.

### Video integration

We set cookies provided by YouTube, Vimeo and others, so that we can show videos on our website. The cookies in question use computer code supplied by the video providers. We have no control over that code. For information about what the companies in question do with the personal and other data collected by their cookies, please refer to the video providers' cookie statements (which are subject to change).

You can refuse our cookies if you wish. To do that, you need to open your browser's 'Settings' menu and follow the instructions provided (Internet Explorer, Safari, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Opera). Please note: the procedure is different for each browser.
